STUDY PLAN

WEEK 1 - A HOLIDAY DAY IN MEXICO

Do you remember that amazing trip you had that changed your life? It'd be incredible if you tell us about it. Learn the vocabulary and tell us!

WEEK 6 - HAVE YOU EVER?

It's time to put into practice everything you learned. Your teacher is going to present situations and you'll have to tell us your experience.

COURSE STRUCTURE

LIVE CLASS

Each week you will take one **75-minute** class with a native speaker online and **40 min** of a live class to practice with a native speaker who **ONLY** speaks Spanish. These classes are designed to keep you talking as much as possible so that you build confidence and fluency.

VOCABULARY APP

Membership to this course gives you access to our courses vocabulary in the Quizlet app. Study the class vocabulary ahead of time so that you are ready to start speaking as soon as the class starts!
